### **NOTICE INVITING TENDERS ON EPAD SYSTEM**

#### **(Single Stage Two Envelopes Procedure)**

1. Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA) invites Bids from all eligible firms / contractors in accordance with "KPPRA Procurement Rules 2014" on "**Single Stage Two Envelopes**" procedure for the following works. The Bidders registered with **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Revenue Authority (KPRA) & Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC)** in relevant category & field of specialization for the year 2026-27, having adequate financial soundness, relevant experience, personnel capabilities, required equipment & other requirements as included in ITB / Bidding Documents can participate in the tender for the following schemes:

2. Bidding Documents, including the Priced BOQ/Engineer's Estimate, Instructions to Bidders (ITB), Evaluation Criteria, etc., are available on the PKHA website ([www.pkha.gov.pk](http://www.pkha.gov.pk)) and the EPAD System (<https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk>), and can be downloaded for bidding purposes.
3. Both Technical and Financial Bids must be submitted online through the EPAD System (<https://kp.eprocure.gov.pk>). However, the **Bid Security (2% of the Estimated Cost) shall be submitted in hard form in a sealed envelope**, clearly marked as "**Bid Security**". Furthermore, the **Non-refundable Tender Entry Fee**, along with an affidavit stating that, "bid security amounting to 2% without indicating the figure in the letter, has been placed in the financial proposal or bid", clearly marked as "**Tender Entry Fee & Affidavit**". Both envelopes must be delivered to the Office of the Deputy Director (Procurement), PKHA Head Office, Attached Departments Complex, Gate No. 5, Khyber Road, Peshawar, on or before the closing date and time.

**Deposits / Bank Guarantees issued by scheduled banks in favor of the Managing Director, PKHA shall be acceptable.**

pre-bid Joint Venture (JV), comprising bidders holding at least the required PEC category (or higher), shall also be eligible to participate in the bidding process. A duly signed JV Agreement must be submitted along with the Technical Proposal. The Technical Bids of the JV shall be evaluated in accordance with the share percentage specified in the JV Agreement executed among the participating firms. The Joint Venture (JV) must comply with the minimum qualification requirements as per PEC Rule 3.3 of the Standard Procedure for Pre-Qualification of Constructors.

- 6. Time allowed for completion shall be intimated in the Commencement letter / Letter of award.**
- 7. Technical Bids shall be opened at 1230 hours on the same day. However, Financial Bids shall be opened after approval of the Technical Evaluation by the Competent Authority.**

## **(INSTRUCTIONS TO THE BIDDERS)**

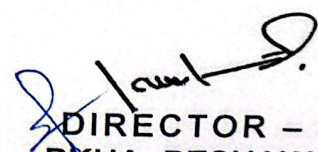
### **(Single Stage Two Envelope)**

1. *The contractors quoting their bids up to a limit of 10% below Engineer estimate shall submit bid security @ 2% only of Engineer Estimate.*
2. *The contractors quoting their bids more than 10% below up to 20% below on Engineers' Estimate shall submit along with their bids 8% Additional Security of Engineer's Estimated cost in addition to 2% bid security. If the bid is not accompanied with the required amount of additional security, then it will be considered as non-responsive and the 2% bid security shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the second lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.*
3. *[Similarly, a contractor quoting bid more than 20% below shall submit with his bid an additional security on Engineer's Estimated cost equal to the differential amount of submitted bid and Engineers' Estimate along with detailed rate analysis].* In case of more than 20% below bids, if the bid is not accompanied by the detailed rate analysis and / or required amount of additional security, then the said bid shall be considered as non-responsive. All the securities submitted along with such non-responsive bid shall be forfeited in favor of Government and the 2nd lowest bidder and so on will be considered accordingly.
4. In case detailed rate analysis submitted with the bids is, in view of the PKHA, not convincing, the Managing Director – PKHA may declare such bid as non-responsive without any forfeiture of bid securities and record reasons thereof.
5. Technical evaluation will be carried out with pass / fail threshold and Evaluation criteria in this regard is given in the Bidding Documents which can be downloaded from the EPADS or official website of PKHA.
6. The bidders are required to quote their rates (electronically) "ABOVE / BELOW / AT PAR". Only two digits after the decimal point shall be considered for evaluation purpose.
7. All other items not mentioned in the BOQ but exist in the **MRS-2025 (1<sup>st</sup> Bi-Annual)** shall be paid at contractor's rate approved by the Competent Authority with approved area cost factor.
8. The Successful bidder shall be subjected to all admissible taxes including stamp duty, service charges, sale tax and any other at prevailing rate.
9. Time allowed for the completion of the work as specified in the NIT shall start from the issuance of Notice of the Engineer.
10. Electronic Bids validity period is 150-days.
11. Successful Bidder should sign the agreement with PKHA within Twenty-Eight (28) days after issuance of Acceptance Letter.
12. If the evaluated electronic bid costs of two or more than two bidders are equal then the successful bid will be declared through **Draw**.
13. The Procuring Entity has the authority to reject any bid or all the bids assigning cogent reasons.



successful bidder shall submit, within 28 days of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the Performance Security at the rate prescribed in the bidding documents, calculated on the accepted bid cost, in the form of a Call Deposit Receipt (CDR) or a Bank Guarantee issued by a scheduled bank in favor of the Managing Director, Pakhtunkhwa Highways Authority (PKHA).

15. Bid security of the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> lowest bidders for the specific work will be retained by the Authority till the approval of bids.
16. A Pre-bid meeting will be held in the office of the undersigned on **28/09/2026** at **11:00 am** for clarification of information regarding the schemes
17. Any clarification regarding bidding documents required, must be communicated on or before **28/09/2026** till 05:00 PM on EPAD System Only.
18. All the information and documents provided by the bidder must be based on facts beyond any doubt. During analysis / Scrutiny or evaluation of the proposals any misrepresentation, false statement or fake document would make a ground for rejection of the bid and will also be liable for debarment / blacklisting. Any fake document or misrepresentation detected during the currency of the contract, will render the firm to be black listed and would be reported to the PEC for cancellation of their registration/license.
